LOCAL NHS FACTS:

MILLIONS WASTED: After 7 years the Government-sponsored "Shaping a Healthier Future" cuts Plan for North West London was finally scrapped without apology. It wasted at least £250 million, mostly on management consultants and bosses. They closed the A&Es at Central Middlesex and Hammersmith and the Maternity Ward and children's A&E at Ealing. All for nothing.



HOSPITALS NOT MAINTAINED: Struggling local Hospital Trusts cannot afford to maintain buildings and equipment, storing up problems for the future. Recently 2 children's wards in Hillingdon had to close for safety reasons.

CATCH 22: Here in Ealing more people were admitted to A&E last year than was in the budget. So the Trust wasn't paid for it - then got fined for being in debt and forced to make even more cuts!

LACK OF GPs: It's hard to get a GP anywhere, but official statistics show that Ealing has 15% less GPs per head than average. Our GPs are under stress - but NHS bosses want to give them even more responsibilities

NATIONAL NHS FACTS:

Shamefully we have FEWER DOCTORS per head than any EU country and **less hospital beds** than almost any other European country. But instead of

increasing beds, Government policy is to restrict treatments, keep people out of hospitals and send them home earlier.

PRIVATISATION In 2012 the Conservative Lib-Dem Government brought in the Health and Social Care Act that forced the NHS to open services to the private market. Since then billions has been given to private companies who get to use the NHS logo but often provide an inferior service.

DRUGS RIP-OFF Last year the NHS drugs bill was £17.4 billion. Although the taxpayer helps pay for drugs research, private companies are allowed to patent the drugs and use their monopoly to charge extortionate prices.

Nightmare Waiting

There are 4.4 million people on NHS waiting lists for routine operations. A&E waiting times are the WORST EVER as the NHS crisis continues.

Unforgivably in our view most children and young people needing mental health support are routinely turned down or have to wait long periods for help.



Boris Johnson has always supported privatisation and budget cuts policies for our NHS.

As the general election neared he promised £1.8 billion "extra" funding for NHS hospitals - but the "new" money wasn't new at all – it was mostly transferred or recycled from other parts of the NHS budget.
